



# UBURGE DELIVERABLE 1: POD GUIDELINES AND AGREEMENT

## 1. Ground Rules

- a. This is a safe space: We all come from different backgrounds and experiences.
  We agree to be respectful of others' experiences and thoughts. Learn from one another, don't be patronizing, and be willing to share in a meaningful way.
- b. Listen actively and attentively: Be present and engaged in the conversation. Use the Stack system to ensure everyone has the opportunity to speak.
- c. Be open to being challenged and receptive to feedback and critique from others. This is a chance for us to learn from each other and grow.
- d. Speak from the first-person perspective (use 'l' rather than 'you,' or 'they') to avoid pointed remarks.
- e. Please be present and engaged: Actively participate, ask questions, attend all meetings, and please inform someone if you cannot make the meeting.
- f. Be conscious of negative body language (such as shaking your head), even over Zoom. Please keep your camera on - as able - to be present in group discussions.
- g. Maintain confidentiality group discussions remain within the group. This is a space where everyone should feel comfortable to speak freely and openly.
- h. Use authors' names when discussing their work. This allows us to recognize the work of these researchers.

### 2. Decision Making

a. Decisions may not always be unanimous - in cases such as these, we will go with a simple majority vote (51%)

#### 3. Roles and responsibilities

- a. Caleb Walcott is the organizer of this asynchronous pod and is responsible for communicating with URGE leadership, submitting URGE deliverables, and on-hand to assist discussion leaders.
- b. Each UBURGE pod member will sign up to co-lead two sessions throughout the semester. Co-leaders are responsible for:
  - i. Posting updates and reminders on Google Drive and Slack as well as sending out the required readings and interview links via email.
  - ii. Preparing discussion questions based the bi-weekly readings and interviews
  - iii. Inviting faculty to participate in meetings as necessary
  - iv. Sharing pertinent information from supplemental readings
  - v. Creating a rough draft of the URGE deliverable before the meeting
  - vi. Compiling information and feedback from the pod and creating the URGE deliverable
  - vii. Sending the deliverable out for review and incorporating edits
  - viii. Communicating with university administration as necessary
  - ix. Posting the final deliverable on Google Drive for Caleb to send to URGE leadership
- c. Note-takers will record notes and attendance from each meeting and post these to Google Drive after the meetings.
