We are committed to our pod's objectives:

- 1. Discuss and assess the racial justice, equity, and inclusivity of our organization.
- 2. Develop an anti-racism Action Plan with actions specific to issues in the earth and marine sciences at UNCW including methods for measuring and reporting progress.
- 3. We will discuss the suggestions and implement procedures described in Dutt (2021) *Addressing racism through ownership*.

We are committed to pursuing these objectives individually, as a pod, and as an organization.
