### ***Deliverable #2 - Pod Agreement***

This agreement is between the EOS URGE pod and Emily Peterman, chair Bowdoin EOS, ~~Hadley Horch, Bowdoin Biology,~~ and Dharni Vasudevan, Associate Dean for Faculty Development and Inclusion.

#### URGE's primary objectives

1. deepen the community's knowledge of the effects of racism on the participation and retention of Black, Brown, and Indigenous people in Geoscience
2. draw on existing literature, expert opinions, and personal experiences to develop anti-racist policies and strategies,
3. share, discuss, and modify anti-racist policies and strategies within a dynamic community network and on a national stage.

#### EOS pod objectives

##### Suggested discussion questions:

- What motivated you to join URGE? What measurable goals do you have for yourself? For your pod? For your organization or institution?

##### JSB –

Motivation: Educate, discuss and share experiences, create and implement anti-racist actionable plans, be accountable.

##### Measurable goals:

Self: Discuss underrepresentation in courses. Highlight contributions from BIPOC in courses. Transparent student hiring practices. Transparent course design with clear expectations for success. Revamp teaching, research, and AJEDI statements to include actionable plans for inclusive practices, which I will implement if hired for a future position.

Motivation: educate, learn from experts within different disciplines, identify ways to discuss race and racism within the context of my courses, continue developing anti-racist teaching practices

Measurable goals: discuss race and racism within my courses; diversify the reading list for my course and include mini-bios for the authors; propose to the Department that we produce an AJEDI statement (perhaps this replaces the current statement on race and racism?); complete readings & contribute to the pod discussions; develop plans for bringing what we've learned and our action items to the Department and to the administration.
