- Invitation for leadership to attend a regular pod meeting for an introduction to URGE and discussion of pod goals
 - o Rebecca Bendick and Robert Woodward are invited to attend one of the URGE pod meetings which are held alternating Thursdays at 5pm ET, Fridays at 3pm ET: e.g. Friday 2/19/21 3pm ET, Thursday 2/25/21 5pm ET, and so on
- Meet with UNAVCO IDEA committee and IRIS JEDI working group February/March
- Follow-up discussion of draft deliverables with Rebecca Bendick and Robert Woodward -September 2021, prior to IRIS and UNAVCO Board of Directors meetings

We are committed to URGE's primary objectives:

- 1. Deepen the community's knowledge of the effects of racism on the participation and retention of black, brown, and indigenous people in Geoscience¹
- 2. Use the existing literature, expert opinion, and personal experiences to develop anti-racist policies and strategies^{2,3}
- 3. Share, discuss, and modify anti-racist policies and strategies within a dynamic community network and on a national stage.

We are committed to our pod's objectives:

- 1. Discuss and assess the racial justice, equity, and inclusivity of our two organizations and the communities we serve.
- 2. Review existing organizational documents and current policies then provide recommendations for improvements that could be adopted by the future merged facility, e.g. hiring policies, job/internship advertisements, field safety, strategic planning.

We are committed to pursuing these objectives individually, as a pod, and as an organization.
