- 5. Schedule meetings with organization/institution leadership (Week X) Each pod member takes responsibility for this (multiple institutions represented).
- 6. Read supplemental articles / materials for deliverables as needed (for example, the asset mapping deliverable will be accompanied by a short paper about the purpose of creating community asset maps and how to generate your own.) *All pod participants agree to this.*
- 7. Draft deliverables and share with pod for review/edits/discussion at the pod meetings *Rotating responsibility among pod members*.
