Session 1: Group norms - setting ground rules

- 1. I will listen actively (and not passively), prioritize listening to other voices, and practice professional etiquette, especially when meeting over Zoom.
- 2. I will acknowledge and accept different points of views.
- 3. I will call people in, instead of calling people out. I will respectfully challenge others but I will refrain from personal attacks.
- 4. I will recognize incommensurability across the disciplines represented by this group.
- 5. I will be accepting of feedback and know that it's never intended to be malicious.
- 6. I will not treat others in this group maliciously.
- 7. I recognize that I and others will probably make mistakes.
- 8. I will commit to the work of the group and prioritize the readings and videos with each session.
- 9. As a group, we will round-robin the responsibilities and duties (such as note taking and providing deliverables to URGE Headquarters).
- 10. As a group, we understand that our members are busy with a variety of responsibilities. We will accept flexibility of individual schedules.
- 11. As a group, we strive to gain a deeper understanding of the issues being discussed during each session.
- 12. As a group, we will maintain confidentiality. All discussions of this group will remain within this group, unless all participants give consent.
