Our Unlearning Racism in Geoscience (URGE; www.urgeoscience.org) pod has collaborated with the leadership to schedule the following meetings:

- Meeting 1 Introduction to URGE and Discussion of Pod Goals Feb 10-15, 2021
- Meeting 2 Invitation for leadership to attend at least one, and as many as desired regular pod meetings alternating Tuesdays at 3pm beginning Feb 16, 2021. Accepted.
- Meeting 3 Follow-Up Discussion of Pod Proposal and Actions TBD following completion of the URGE program on May 7, 2021, Agreed on.

We are committed to URGE's primary objectives:

- 1. Deepen the community's knowledge of the effects of racism on the participation and retention of black, brown, and indigenous people in Geoscience and related fields 1
- 2. Use the existing literature, expert opinion, and personal experiences to develop and implement anti-racist policies and strategies 2,3
- 3. Share, discuss, and modify anti-racist policies and strategies within a dynamic community network and on a national stage.

We are committed to our pod's objectives:

- 1. Discuss and assess the racial justice, equity, and inclusivity of our organization.
- 2. Develop an anti-racism Action Plan with actions specific to issues at UMCES/HPL, including methods for measuring and reporting progress. It is anticipated that the Action Plan will also enhance LGBTQ+, differently abled, neurodiverse and gender justice, equity and inclusivity.

We are committed to pursuing these objectives individually, as a pod, and as an organization.
