What		At undergraduate level (Geosciences): Geosciences has made significant progress in the number of majors in targeted¹ student categories. Targeted students have increased from 7.9% of majors in 2011 to 25.7% in Fall 2020. This is higher than the national average and slightly higher than the UWM-wide average of ~24%. Growth has been primarily in students identifying as Latina/Latino and as multi-ethnic. Geosciences still lags significantly behind the UWM population in the proportion of Black/African-American students (2.7% vs 6.5%). At graduate level (for all UWM): a steady increase in targeted student enrollment from 10% in 2006 to 15% in 2018 (growth mostly in students identifying as multi-ethnic). Within Geosciences, we still struggle to attract these students.
